Successful candidates will be expected to teach medical, professional, graduate, and undergraduate students in pathology.

State-funded salary commensurate with experience and state-of-the-art educational facilities in the Lee Medical Science Building (Vermillion, SD) will be provided. Application should include a letter of application, a statement of teaching philosophy, a current curriculum vitae/resume showing teaching experience, and the names, addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses of three references that can specifically comment on the applicant's teaching abilities.
